Annotation Project

The University of Maryland Applied Research Lab for Intelligence and Security is seeking applicants to assist on full- or part-time basis (up to 40 hours per week) providing English language support on an annotation project. The annotation task will use a specialized tool for marking spans of text (sequence of words) as names, events and relations, all of specific types. For example, an event might be a financial transaction: a purchase, sale, or other payment.

We anticipate that annotation will start soon and will last for a three or more months. Training and written guidelines will be provided, although it is expected that guidelines will require modification during the course of the annotation work.

Requirements:

- Fluent reading ability;
- Excellent English skills;
- Standard computer skills;
- Computer and internet access (to be used for remote work);
- Attention to detail;
- U.S. citizenship;
- Previous annotation experience and/or coursework in linguistics (preferred).

Remote work on this project is possible.
